Dear Chairman Tauzin:

The Energy and Commerce Committee may soon have an opportunity to consider an amendment offered by Representative John Shadegg (R-AZ) that would set forth several essential Emergency Medical Treatment and Active Labor Act (EMTALA) reforms. We understand that Representative Shadegg is working to incorporate the amendment into the Chairman's mark for consideration by the full Committee. The medical organizations listed below strongly support this amendment and urge your favorable consideration of the language when it is brought before the Committee.

The proposed EMTALA amendment would address several of the EMTALA problems that physicians and hospitals in communities across the nation are experiencing. Specifically, the amendment would:

- Establish an EMTALA Task Force to review existing EMTALA regulations
- Require the Secretary to notify providers, physicians and hospitals when an EMTALA investigation is closed
- Require peer review prior to terminating a provider from Medicare for an EMTALA violation

The Office of the Inspector General (OIG) identified many of these problems in a report issued in January of this year, in which it also recommended that an EMTALA Task Force be formed to address these problems. The General Accounting Office report in June (*EMTALA Implementation and Enforcement Issues*) echoed similar concerns about EMTALA. Likewise, Secretary Thompson acknowledged the confusion surrounding EMTALA and the need for appropriate remedies during a July Congressional hearing on regulatory reform.

We urge your support for the EMTALA amendment when it is brought before the Committee.
