Dear Doctor Kang:

The undersigned medical societies are writing to strongly urge the Health Care Financing Administration (HCFA) to extend the deadline for comments on HCFA's administrative coverage policy process for an additional 30-60 days. Background materials for Friday's Town Hall meeting were not distributed to attendees until Friday, September 18. Three weeks is not a sufficient period of time to develop meaningful comments. In fact, perhaps unintentionally, the extremely short comment period implies that HCFA may not be sincerely interested in receiving meaningful comments.

Beyond the written materials, a number of ideas for HCFA's administrative process were discussed for the first time at the Town Hall meeting. In response to the questions raised by HCFA staff before and during the meeting, attendees suggested several alternatives for consideration, such as having a smaller advisory committee, structuring the committee around clinical areas rather than benefit types, and dealing with the perception that a formal appeals process is necessary. Two weeks is simply not a long enough time to permit careful consideration of these alternatives and development of comments. Regardless of whether HCFA proceeds with plans to issue a final notice or decides to develop a proposed rule, it will be very difficult for organizations to provide the agency with the type of feedback that will be most useful to either process by mid-October.

We would appreciate your prompt and serious consideration of this request.
