Fall 2024 BOG Meeting Update

The Fall BOG meeting was held in Boston September 19-21, 2024. Chapter Governor Ann Maguire and Chapter Executive Jenni Kilpatrick represented the Wisconsin Chapter.

During the meeting Ann and Jenni participated in several sessions about Chapter best practices in financial management, membership recruitment and advocacy. They also learned about ways to enhance Chapter collaboration with other ACP Chapters. ACP Wisconsin received a Gold Chapter Excellence Award. At the Business Meeting, the resolution submitted by our own HPPC # 08-F24 Developing Policy on Reducing Traffic Fatalities and Injuries in the United States was recommended for adoption by the BOG and is currently under review by the Board of Regents.
