

## Robert M. Monger, MD, FACP



Dr. Monger grew up in Cheyenne and is a proud graduate of Cheyenne East High School. He attended medical school at the University of Utah, and completed an internal medicine residency at Michigan State University and then a rheumatology fellowship at the University of Colorado,

before returning to Cheyenne to practice. Early in his career, he practiced traditional, small-town, primary care internal medicine as well as rheumatology, providing both inpatient and outpatient care. He also served as the Hospice Medical Director for Cheyenne Regional Medical Center and the Davis Hospice Center for 14 years.

Dr. Monger is board-certified in internal medicine and rheumatology. He has been actively involved in organized medicine in Wyoming, serving in various roles, including President of the Wyoming Medical Society, Chief of Staff at Cheyenne Regional Medical Center, Wyoming Delegate to the American Medical Association, and Governor of the Wyoming Chapter of the American College of Physicians (ACP). He has also taught medical students and residents for many years and served on the Wyoming WWAMI Medical School Admissions Committee for 6 years, including 2 years as Chair.

Currently, Dr. Monger is the Clinical Dean of the Wyoming WWAMI Medical School Program and a Clinical Associate Professor of Medicine at the University of Washington School of Medicine.
