




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Become an ACP Fellow (FACP®)

- Fellowship in the American College of Physicians is a peer-reviewed and peersupported credential that is a public reflection of excellence within the internal medicine profession. FACP signifies an ongoing dedication to the profession of internal medicine, the patients we care for, and the communities we serve.
- If you can check all of these requirements ...
 - At least 3 years' experience post residency training
 - ACP member in good standing for 3 of the past 4 years
 - Initial Board certified in internal medicine or neurology
 - Active medical license in good standing (if in clinical practice)
